Besides, he could see that persons with intellectual disabilities were so happy and strengthened their selfconfidence in the process of cooking when partnering the students or members of Legislative Council, the event was so meaningful and hoped that everyone in the society would show more concern for persons with intellectual disabilities. Another judge, Mr Billy Yeung had a view that the standard of participants was high and their creativity in matching the ingredients and cooking method could encourage him to create new dishes. Also, it provided an opportunity for people in the community to understand more about persons with intellectual disabilities and in return, persons with intellectual disabilities could show their talents and meet more new friends that could help foster social inclusion.
