The Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities has stipulated that people with disabilities are entitled to a barrier-free environment and involvement in social affairs. This year, with more than \$30,000 sponsorship from the Southern District Council, Fu Hong Society's Rehabilitation Centre has formed a social inclusion volunteer group comprising persons with and without intellectual, physical and psychiatric disabilities, as well as deaf-mute people. The purpose of the group is to allow persons with disabilities to experience that they may also be able to take part in volunteer work and contribute to the community through joint participation in volunteer training, preparation and visits, as long as there are barrier-free facilities and transports.

The volunteer group arranged volunteer visits to CLMT Care and Attention Home for the Aged and HKCS Wah Hong Hostel in December 2012 and March 2013. We would like to express our sincere thanks for the participation and support of Mr Wong Lingsun and Mr Chu Lap-wai, members of the Southern District Council, as well as their participation in the volunteer recognition ceremony. In planning the activities and visits, the volunteers have shown their pro-activeness, their passion to play an active role and their spirit of mutual support. The volunteer group was honoured that starting in the ensuring year, its activities would be funded by S.K. Yee Medical Foundation with more than \$76,000 for two years. It is anticipated that the volunteer group will continue to promote the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, in addition to disseminating to the community information about social inclusion.
