The three "A Special Journey" microfilm screenings were joined by 70 Wheelock Properties staff, about 300 students of Ng Yuk Secondary School and over 30 students from "Project WeCan". In addition to the microfilm screening, Ms. Mei Yung, the inspiration of the protagonist of the microfilm, also made an appearance to share the difficulties and needs, unique talents and gifts of persons



with disabilities with the participants. Mr. WONG Ricky, Vice Chairman and Executive Director of Wheelock Properties, urged participants to extend their care to disadvantaged groups. Putting their ideas into practice, Wheelock Properties supported our social enterprise restaurant – Madam Hong Restaurant by ordering its lunch boxes for their participating staff.
