
2013年度香港最佳老友全港分社 周年聚會暨傑出分社選舉頒獎典禮




2013 "Best Buddies Hong Kong" Movement (BBHK) Annual Gala and Outstanding **Chapter Award Ceremony**

The Macau Exchange Tour ran from 31 May to 1 June 2013. 16 pairs of best buddies joined the tour. A seminar to promote social inclusion was arranged in the afternoon of 31 May to discuss different experiences in promoting "Best Buddies Hong Kong" Movement. Council members of BBHK, including Mrs. Cecilia Wong Lam MH, Fr. Giosuè Bonzi, and Mr. John Lee supported and shared in the seminar. Mr. Chan Choi Fat (Chairman of Management Committee of Fuhong Society of Macau) and Ms. Jennifer Chau (Director of Fuhong Society of Macau), together with around 30 staff and service users, attended the seminar.

During the seminar, members of senior management, 4 buddy pairs and 1 student representative presented BBHK, introduced BBHK and shared their experience joining BBHK. As well as visiting the Associacao de Reabilitacao "Fu Hong" de Macau Centro Pou Choi and Centro Hong Leng, the group also went to the Assoicicao dos Familiares Encarregados dos Complexo de servicos "Hong Lok". The Macau Exchange Tour reunion and sharing session was held on 29 June 2013.

The 24th Best Buddies International Annual Leadership Conference was held at Indiana University from 16 to 22 July 2013. FHS delegates were social worker Ms. Kwok Wing Lam, and two buddies from our tertiary institutes chapters, Ms. Rachel Chan from the Hong Kong Institute of Education Advanced Diploma of Social Work Branch (paired with Kwai Hing Vocational Development Centre) and Ms. Alma Cheung of the Hong Kong Shue Yan University Chapter (paired with Chak On Adult Training Centre). On 28 August 2013, after their return from the conference, they shared their learning experiences with the staff of "Best Buddies Hong Kong" Movement.

Sitting in the audience, I was excited to listen to "America's Best Buddies Ambassadors" giving their speeches on stage. In front of 1,500 people, one of the Ambassadors stated his belief that: "Disability is merely a defect in our bodies that prevents us from achieving certain things, however, everyone has a list of things they cannot do." I was even more touched by the friendship between the buddies! These friendships were based on equality, mutual love, and friendship, and have transformed both those with and without intellectual disabilities. Everyone needs a true

Sham Shui Po "You are my Best Buddies" **Inclusion with Disabilities Project**

FHS received a grant totaling \$81308 from Sham Shui Po District Council to implement a "You are my Best Buddies" Inclusion with Disabilities Project in the District, from September 2013 to March 2014. The project is led by FHS Chak On Adult Training Centre, Cheung Sha Wan Adult Training Centre and Sheung Li Uk Adult Training Centre, jointly organized by Working Group on Elderly and Rehabilitation Service of Council Community Affairs of Sham Shui Po District, and supported by the Caritas Cheng Shing Fung District Elderly Centre (Sham Shui Po) and The Hong Kong Association of Senior Citizens. The project will primarily involve comprehensive talent training workshops, "Warmth Action" volunteer visits, and slogan competitions, in order to connect together Sham Shui Po's persons with intellectual disabilities, seniors and students, to promote the message of inclusion, and to foster friendships between those with and without intellectual disabilities, on the basis of equality and mutual respect.
