



# 「畫中·寄情」作品展

“Expressing Love through Art” Mini Exhibition  
——以畫傳情—— Passing on the love with art

本會上李屋成人訓練中心早前舉辦「畫中·寄情」作品展，展示出服務使用者多年的藝術創作，並希望透過作品展讓社會人士能夠透過畫作進入服務使用者的內心世界，認識到他們的能力和潛能。

「畫中·寄情」作品展共設有三個藝術創作展區、一個工作坊及一個創作攤位。藝術創作展區由服務使用者擔任導賞員，向各位來賓介紹各畫作的特色。此外，亦設有「立智的光輝」展館，紀念中心一位生前熱愛繪畫的服務使用者立智，運用畫作展示她如何用畫筆繪畫其燦爛的一生。

另外，畫展設有藝術工作坊和創作攤位，讓來賓體驗藝術的樂趣。由服務使用者擔任駐場書法家及藝術家，即場按嘉賓的喜好製作手寫潮語明信片及隨性寫生繪畫。是次畫展亦運用了服務使用者的畫作設計了數款文件夾和口罩套，供來賓留念。

來賓對活動均有正面評價，表示感受到服務使用者對生活的熱誠及潛能發揮的無限性。

Our service users acted as the docents in the exhibition areas, and introduced the art works to the guests. Moreover, the “Lap Chi’s Brilliance” Pavilion commemorates Lap Chi, who was our service user and passionate about painting during her lifetime, of which her paintings presented the ways in which she paints her a magnificent life with her paintbrush.

Moreover, the workshop and creation booth at the exhibition allowed the public to experience the fun in art. Our service users had become the calligraphers and artists onsite as well; they made handwritten postcards and sketches based on the preferences of the guests at

the exhibition. Besides, the Society has adapted few artworks designed by service users to reproduce files and surgical mask holders as keepsakes for guests.

The event has received positive feedbacks from the guests, and they have witnessed our service users' passion towards life and their unlimited potential.
