



# 會長報告

今年是香港特別行政區成立十周年，亦是扶康會成立三十周年。在過去三十年間，本會得到社會各界人士、團體、服務使用者、家長及職員的支持，讓我們可以為殘疾人士及其家人發展切合需要的創新服務。

除了本會早年拓展的三類核心服務——住宿服務、日間訓練服務及職業康復服務、外展及社區支援服務外，本會亦積極拓展新服務及發展新的訓練模式，以回應社會需要及促進殘疾人士的全人發展。我們近年拓展的項目包括自閉症人士發展及支援中心、扶康家庭、感覺統合治療服務中心、社會企業——康融服務有限公司、「香港最佳老友」運動、認知行為治療計劃、生活經驗互動訓練、多媒體輔助訓練、視訊關懷網計劃、澳門扶康會等。

本會過去的成就，除了是我們員工及家長的努力外，外界的支持實在不可或缺。過去一年，本會很高興得到東瀛遊旅行社有限公司贊助18萬2千元予本會自閉症人士發展及支援中心購置中心小巴，並成功申請「攜手扶弱基金」第三輪撥款，獲資助同等金額。此外，本會亦獲 Capital Lake Property Ltd 捐款20萬元，我們計劃利用捐款成立扶康會合作社，並申請「攜手扶弱基金」按額資助。我們多年的支持團體葵涌扶輪社捐贈30萬元，為本會麗瑤之家設置電動天花搬扶吊機，除了可使服務使用者在被搬扶時較為舒適外，更改善員工在協助殘疾服務使用者轉移時的工作安全，有效防止工傷意外。

在2006年及2007年上旬，本會多個大型活動均得到各界人士的鼎力協助，活動包括「飛躍舞台」智障人士時裝表演、慈善音樂會及粵曲晚會，以及多項三十週年紀念慶祝活動，包括「社區融合新路向」會議、自閉症人士發展及支援中心開幕典禮暨研討會、關愛三十載——中華書法比賽、步行籌款等。我們亦深感榮幸及高興獲得多位知名人士蒞臨主禮，他們包括前衛生福利及食物局局長周一嶽醫生、社會福利署助理署長(康復及醫務社會服務)薛棟先生、南區區議會主席馬月霞女士、社會福利署南區福利專員郭志良先生、社會福利署荃灣及葵青區福利專員吳家謙先生、香港理工大學康復治療科學系教授及系主任陳智軒教授等。

# President's Report

This year we see Fu Hong Society marching into its 30th anniversary, which also coincides with the 10th anniversary of the establishment of the HKSAR. We are grateful that continuous support from the general public, community organizations, service users, their parents and our staff in the past 30 years has enabled us to develop innovative services to meet the needs of persons with disabilities and their families.

Apart from the three core services — residential service, day training service and vocational rehabilitation service, outreaching and community support service — we developed in early years, our Society has also endeavoured to develop new services and training approaches in response to social needs and enhancing whole person development for persons with disabilities. Our recent innovations include Development and Support Centre for Persons with Autism, Casa Famiglia, Sensory Integration Therapy Centre, Social Enterprise — Hong Yung Services Limited, “Best Buddies Hong Kong” Movement, Cognitive Behavioural Therapy, Life Experience Interactive Training, Multimedia-assisted Training, Cyber Care Project and Fu Hong Society of Macau etc.

External support is also indispensable to our Society's past achievements apart from the hard work of our staff and parents. In the past year, we were delighted to receive a donation of \$182,000 from Evergloss Tours Co. Ltd. for our Development and Support Centre for Persons with Autism to purchase a Society van. This had enabled our successful application of a third round matching grant from the Partnership Fund for the Disadvantaged. Moreover, we also planned to establish Fu Hong Co-op Shop with the \$200,000 donation from Capital Lake Property Ltd. and apply for a subsequent matching grant from the Partnership Fund for the Disadvantaged. In addition, we had also received a generous donation of \$300,000 from our long-time sponsor, Rotary Club

of Kwai Chung, to install electric ceiling hoists at Lai Yiu Home that greatly improved the job safety of staff in transferring service users and effectively prevented accidents at work.

During 2006 and the first half of 2007, many of our mass programmes had received enthusiastic support from the general public. These included “Flying on the Stage” A fashion Show by Persons with Mental Handicap, Charity Concert and Charity Cantonese Operatic Songs Concert, as well as numerous functions and activities commemorating the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary, including the Conference on “New Initiatives in Community Integration”, Opening Ceremony cum Seminar of the Development and Support Centre for Persons with Autism, Thirty Years of Caring — Chinese Calligraphy Competition and Walkathon etc. We were also honoured to have prominent figures in town to be our guests of honor, Dr. York Chow, S.B.S., J.P., ex-Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food; Mr. Sit Tung, Assistant Director (Rehabilitation and Medical Social Services), Social Welfare Department; Ms. Mar Yuet Har, M.H., Chairman of District Council; Mr Kok Che Leung, Southern District Social Welfare Officer (Southern), Social Welfare Department; Mr. Ng Ka Him, District Social Welfare Officer (Tsuen Wan and Kwai Tsing);
