Under the careful guidance of the instructors, service users at Jockey Club Shek Wai Kok Workshop of Fu Hong Society have crafted the high-quality ceramic cups and slow feed bowls for pets. Through the pottery skills, it aims to fully showcase the professional ceramic craftsmanship and delicate artistry of persons with disabilities.

The process of making the antique ceramic cups involves numerous challenging steps. With the assistance of our instructors, the service users first prepare the clay slip, followed by pouring the slip into molds. They then refine the edges of the pottery, apply glaze to the unfired pieces, and finally fire them at high temperatures to ensure the cups are smooth, delicate, and durable, while also possessing a unique handmade texture.

The pet slow feed bowls, on the other hand, are entirely handmade by the service users without the use of any molds. They utilize throwing and shaping techniques to carefully craft the bowl and the special textures within it, paying attention to every detail. The adorable cat and dog patterns in the bowls are also hand-sculpted by our service users, demonstrating their high level of professionalism and patience, resulting in unique products. Each piece embodies the dedication of the service users and the care of the instructors, showcasing a distinctive handmade warmth and personality.

陶瓷杯的製作過程工序繁多且具挑戰性，在本會導師的協助下，先調配陶泥漿，再進行倒模灌漿，然後為陶器細緻修邊、素坯施釉，最後以高溫入窯燒製，確保杯身光滑細緻、堅固耐用，同時伴隨著獨特的手作質感。而另一款寵物慢食碗則是全程由服務使用者以純手工方式製作，過程中並沒有使用任何模具。他們運用拉坯及塑形技巧，仔細塑造碗身和慢食碗中特製的紋理，修整每個細節。而碗中可愛的貓狗圖案也是由他們親手捏，展現出高度專業和耐心，製作出一件件獨一無二的產品。每一件作品都凝聚了服務使用者的心血與導師的用心，展現獨特的手工溫度與個性。
