



本會一直以「以求為導、以愛同行」的服務精神，配合社會發展和服務使用者的需要，以愛為服務使用者及家屬提供適切服務，與他們同行。本期通訊就以「發展新動向」作主題，分享本會服務的最新發展。

為回應特殊學校畢業生及其照顧者的需要，天水圍地區支援中心新設立了「特殊學校離校生專隊」，幫助他們過渡至人生新階段。同時，位於古洞的兩間新服務單位亦即將投入服務。為應對服務使用者日趨嚴重的老化情況，本會推行「賽馬會安寧頌：融和篇」服務，提供舒緩和晚期照顧服務予服務使用者。

此外，賽馬會石圍角工場開展了「優化職業康復服務試驗計劃」，協助服務使用者為職業發展做好準備。以及，本會三間宿舍亦開展「一站式日間訓練及照顧試驗計劃」，以提高年邁服務使用者的生活質素。而今期「人物故事」介紹輸入護理員，分享這批「新力軍」對服務單位的支援，以及任職的經驗與得著。

本會致力讓服務使用者發揮潛能，「機構動態」和「社會支持」兩部分均分享推廣展能藝術的概況。「外間聯繫」部分則有本會與內地交流活動的花絮，以及上李屋成人訓練中心服務使用者製作的手工藝品推介。

Upholding the spirit of “Your Need is the Lead, Walk together with Love”, it is Fu Hong Society’s mission to provide loving care for service users and their families, while integrating social development with the needs of service users. This issue’s theme is “Latest Development”, we will be sharing the latest service developments at the Society.

To respond to the needs of school leavers of special school and their caregivers, the Tin Shui Wai District Support Centre has put together a “Designated Team for Special School Leavers” to support school leavers to transition to a new stage in life. Two brand new service units in Kwu Tung will soon begin service. To address the issue of accelerating service users aging, the Society launches the “Jockey Club End-of-Life Community Care Project: Unison” to provide quality palliative and end-of-life care to our service users.

Moreover, we are also pleased to introduce the “Pilot Project on Enhancing Vocational Rehabilitation Services” at the Jockey Club Shek Wai Kok Workshop to prepare service users for career development. Three of our hostels have begun

the “Pilot Project on One-stop Services for Ageing Service Users of Hostel for Severely Mentally Handicapped Persons and Hostels for Moderately Mentally Handicapped Persons” to improve the quality of life of elderly service users. This issue’s “Character Story” features import care workers. Apart from sharing the invaluable support these newcomers have contributed to their service units, we will also delve into their experiences and takeaways at the service units.

We are committed to bringing about the full potential of our service users. More on our campaign for arts with the persons with disabilities can be found on the “Organization Activities” and “Social Support” sections. The section on “External Connection” will present exchanges between the Society and the Mainland, as well as highlights of handicrafts made by service users of the Sheung Li Uk Adult Training Centre.
